The Executive Office of Health & Human Services, Ryan White HIV Provision of Care & Special Populations is excited to announce that effective November 21, 2016, the Executive Office of Health and Human Services, ADAP Drug Assistance Program will be expanding its ADAP drug formulary. Medications currently on the Drug Assistance Formulary will not be changed. The below lists includes the expansion medication categories:

- a. Antihypertensives
- b. Diuretics
- c. Cardiovascular Agents
- d. Anti-Hyperlipidemics
- e. Agents treating diabetes
- f. Antipsychotics
- g. Antiemetics
- h. Antidiarrheals
- i. Gastrointestinal agents
- j. Non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs)
- k. Smoking cessation products and agents for alcohol and opioid dependence

Please note that some agents or products may include over the counter (OTC) items (ex: nicotine patches or insulin needles). A prescription will still be required for all items to be dispensed to a EOHHS, Drug Assistance Program beneficiary.

The above listed expansion medications are consistent with the fee for service (FFS) Medicaid reimbursement system.
