Integrated Care Initiative -Phase I

The RI Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) implemented the Integrated Care Initiative in November 2013 with the first group of eligible individuals enrolling. Approximately 30,000 Rhode Islanders are eligible and have been offered enrollment in one of two new health care options- *Rhody Health Options* through Neighborhood Health Plan of RI or *Connect Care Choice Community Partners*, in partnership with CareLink. The last group of Medicare/Medicaid recipients and Medicaid only recipients to enroll received their enrollment letters in the first week of February 2014. This final group to be offered enrollment include adults with Serious and Persistent Mental Illness (SPMI) and adults with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (IDD). This group also includes individuals in the Personal Choice Program and Shared Living Program (Rite@Home). This last group includes individuals living in the community and also those receiving long term services and supports.

This is a voluntary enrollment. Consumers must “opt-out” if they don’t want to enroll in one of the new health care options.

Please note that services provided through the Dept. of BHDDH will not change in Phase 1 of the Integrated Care Initiative. These services include: Long-term Services and Supports for adults with IDD and Intensive Behavioral Health Services for adults with SPMI.

Integrated Care Initiative- Phase II

Rhode Island will be pursuing a Phase II to the Integrated Care Initiative. This second phase would fully integrate Medicaid and Medicare services delivered by a health plan. The state will procure for additional health plans that wish to participate. There will be a revised timeline on the EOHHS website for this phase. As part of this process, the state will engage community partners and providers to solicit input. The tentative start date for Phase II is April 2015, but this is subject to CMS and EOHHS timelines.
