### **General Statement of Duties:**

Full-time position solely dedicated to the MFP Demonstration Project. The Transition Assessment Registered Nurse will be a part of the Assessment Team providing the clinical medical perspective.

### **Specific duties include:**

- Review referrals for transition including the MDS forms submitted by nursing homes,
- Conduct on site assessments including a risk assessment for transition,
- Consult with patient's health care providers and MFP project's medical consultants (i.e. Gerontologist, Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapist) about the patient,
- Refer potentially eligible MFP participants to the appropriate DHS Long Term Care unit to determine financial eligibility and to the Office of Medical review to determine clinical eligibility,
- Determine medical needs required for transition,
- Provide MFP Program information and options counseling to patient/family and determine desire to participate,
- Develop a Care Plan including Back-up Safety Plan with patient, family and other Care Team members,
- Participate in nursing home discharge planning meetings,
- Arrange for (or confirm that) required transition medical services,
- Follow-up with the patient and providers within 30 days to assure that medical services are provided and needs are being met.

### **Education / Experience / Special Requirements**

**Education:** Graduation from an accredited school of nursing and/or graduation from a college of recognized standing involving a program of study in nursing

**Experience:** The individual must have considerable employment providing professional services involving clinical and/or educational health work, or any combination of experience that shall be substantially equivalent to the above education and experience..
