

Provider Electronic Solutions (PES)

Providers will learn how to install and upgrade the PES software and build a client database. Provider will also review submission of claims and troubleshooting using PES. Providers will have an opportunity to ask questions during a live demo.

Using the Healthcare Portal

Community Health Team RI (CHT-RI): CHT- RI is Primary Care Case Management program for eligible adults with Medicaid Fee for Service Coverage.

Integrated Care Initiative (ICI) Phase II. ICI Phase II coordinates both Medicare and Medicaid benefits into one integrated delivery system for eligible members.

EHR Incentive Program - MAPIR

Intended audience: Physicians, Hospitals, Nurse Practitioners, Certified Nurse Midwives, and Dentists

Providers will review latest updates for the EHR Incentive Program.

CurrentCare, SHIFT, and TCPI

Providers will learn about the latest CurrentCare advances, including Viewer and Care Management Alerts, as well as the new Care Management Dashboards and CurrentCare for Me products and services. Providers will also learn about two recently-funded initiatives and how they can participate: Sharing Health Information for Transitions of Care (SHIFT) – available to all long-term care facilities; and Transforming Clinical Practice Initiative (TCPI) – specifically designed to help specialty providers transform their practices with the use of a practice facilitator, clinical practice advisor, and quality improvement advisor. RIQI staff will be on hand at the event to provide additional information.
