## 2/7/2022 PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO RHODE ISLAND MEDICAID STATE PLAN

In accordance Rhode Island General Laws 42-35, notice is hereby given that the Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) proposes to make the following amendment to the Rhode Island State Plan under Title XIX of the Social Security Act:

## Standards for Optional State Supplementary Payments and Medically Needy Income Limit

EOHHS is making the annual update to the Medicaid State Plan to reflect the federal government's guidance on State Supplementary Payments and the Medically Needy Income Limit. The Social Security Administration approved a 5.9% cost-of-living increase for 2022. The state's supplementary payments and Medically Needy Income Limit have been adjusted to reflect that increase. These changes will yield an estimated annual increase of approximately \$376,000 and will be effective January 1, 2022.

In accordance with the Rhode Island General Laws 42-35-3, an oral hearing will be granted on the proposed State Plan Amendment if requested by twenty-five (25) persons, an agency, or by an association having at least twenty-five (25) members. A request for an oral hearing must be made within fourteen (14) days of this notice.
