Summary of Rulemaking Action:

Pursuantto 42 U.S.C. §415(i), the federal government is required to make annualCOLA adjustments to SSI benefits. We must reflect those updates in our regulations. The following items are being updated in the regulation: Monthly Federal Benefit Rate (FBR), Optional State Supplement Payment (SSP) Limits, Medically Needy Income Standard for Non-LTSS Elders and Adults with Disabilities & Refugee Medical Assistance, Student Earned Income Exclusion, Maximum Monthly Maintenance of Need Allowance, Minimum/Maximum Community Spouse Resource Standards, Minimum Home Equity Limit, and Medically Needy Standards by Family Size.

The updated dollar amounts in this regulation directly impact Medicaid benefits and eligibility and are effective as of 1/1/2023.

The Agency does not expect this filing to be controversial and therefore, a public hearing will not be held.

If no formal objection is received on or before April 22, 2023, the Executive Office of Health and Human Services will file the Amendment and the Final Rule will take effect on this date.
